ORDINANCE NO. 1010

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING BY PROHIBITING
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON A CERTAIN ROADWAY
WITHIN THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, KANSAS BY ADDING
NEW SECTION 10.20.085 TO THE CLEARWATER, KANSAS
MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Clearwater, Kansas, has determined it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Clearwater, Kansas that vehicle parking should be prohibited on Fourth Avenue commencing at its intersection with Ross Avenue and continuing north to the corporate limits of the City of Clearwater, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Adding New Section 10.20.085 to the Code

New Section 10.20.085 is hereby added to the Clearwater, Kansas Municipal Code to read as follows:

“Section 10.20.085 - Parking on Certain Roadways – Prohibited or Limited.

(a) Prohibited or Limited. - When signs are posted:

(1) Parking is prohibited on Fourth Avenue commencing at its intersection with Ross Avenue and continuing north to the corporate limits of the City of Clearwater, Kansas.

(b) Definitions.

(1) Parking - The standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and actually engaged in loading and unloading passengers or property.

(2) Vehicle – For the purposes of this Section, vehicle includes motor vehicles, recreational vehicles, commercial vehicles, utility trailers, house trailers, damaged or disabled vehicles, as defined in Section 10.20.005, and every other device in, upon, or

by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a roadway."

Section 2. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official city newspaper. Enforcement may commence upon the posting of signs prohibiting and/or limiting vehicle parking as declared herein.

Adopted by the City Council this 8th day of March, 2016.



