ORDINANCE NO. 992

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SERVING OF COMPLIMENTARY ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR OR CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE ON THE UNLICENSED PREMISES OF BUSINESSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, KANSAS IN SUPPORT OF THE 2015 ANNUAL SPRING ART WALK IN ACCORDANCE WITH K.S.A. 41-104(i).

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 41-104(i) authorizes the serving of complimentary alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage on the unlicensed premises of a business by the business owner or owner's agent at an event sponsored by a nonprofit organization promoting the arts which has been approved by ordinance or resolution of the governing body of the city, county or township wherein the event will take place and whereby the director of the alcoholic beverage control has been notified thereof no less than 10 days in advance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clearwater, Kansas received a formal request from Ms. Tricia Nichols, on behalf of the Clearwater Community Foundation and the Clearwater Chamber of Commerce, nonprofit organizations promoting the arts within the City of Clearwater, Kansas, to approve the serving of complimentary alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage on the unlicensed premises of businesses within the corporate limits of the City of Clearwater, Kansas in support of the 2015 Annual Spring Art Walk in accordance with K.S.A. 41-104(i).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. APPROVAL. The serving of complimentary alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage on the unlicensed premises of businesses within the corporate limits of the City of Clearwater, Kansas in support of the 2015 Annual Spring Art Walk, sponsored by the Clearwater Community Foundation and the Clearwater Chamber of Commerce, nonprofit organizations promoting the arts within the City of Clearwater, Kansas, is hereby approved upon proper notification of the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control no less than 10 days in advance of said Spring Art Walk in accordance with K.S.A. 41-104(i).

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in force and effect after publication of its summary in the official City newspaper.
