ORDINANCE NO. 995

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 2014 EDITION, AS AMENDED AND APPLIED BY SEDGWICK COUNTY RESOLUTION NUMBER 159-2014 AND REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CLEARWATER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Incorporating National Electric Code

There is hereby incorporated by reference that certain code known as the National Electrical Code, 2014 Edition, prepared and published in book form by the National Fire Protection Association, 1 Batterymarch Park, Quincy, Massachusetts 02169, as amended and applied by Sections 1 through 14 of Resolution Number 159-2014 of the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas. No fewer than three (3) copies of said National Electrical Code, 2014 Edition, and Sedgwick County Resolution Number 159-2014 shall be marked "Official Copy as adopted by Ordinance No. 995," to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. Repeal

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the official city newspaper.
